Let's Act and Sing! (ages 6 – 8) / Acting Up! (ages 9 – 13)
Fall-Winter Session: October 6 – January 22 / Winter-Spring Session: February 9 – Jun 1
All sessions are 13 weeks in length / Class sizes are limited to 14 per class, so please register early to reserve your place!

Level 1: 6-8 years Weekly / 13 hours / 1 hour weekly

LET'S ACT & SING - A fun introduction to the dramatic arts

Through storytelling, children learn to think creatively, as well as empathize with and gain an understanding of others. An experienced coach will guide them in exploring their imagination and in expressing feelings through drama. The children will use role-playing to act out short stories & plays based on diverse age-approproate themes. Short movement routines set to music help develop physical coordination and introduce each child to music and listening skills. Through vocal exercises & song the students learn to speak with clarity, and gain in overall personal confidence, contributing to the growth of public speaking and leadership skills. A short presentation for parents & friends will take place at the last class of each session The final class of each level 1 session consists of 40 minutes dress rehearsal & 20 minutes presentation.

Level 2: 9-13 years Weekly / 19.5 hours / 1.5 hours weekly

ACTING UP! - Express your creative side, have fun & meet friends

The students focus on producing and performing a play. Strategy and problem solving skills are gained through active involvement in scripted plays and dramatic scenes, as well as through playwriting. Role play and characterization are developed through forms such as improvisation, reader's theatre and musical theatre Stage presence is built through the use of such tools as tableaux, positioning, stage blocking, direction and vocalizing. The students learn technical terms to communicate ideas in dramatic context. They are encouraged to use their imaginations to create fun movement routines, free-style improvisations and dance choreographies set to music. Vocal spontaneity and clarity is expressed through songs, choral pieces and vocal exercises A presentation for parents & friends will take place at the last class of each workshop session. The final class of each level 2 session consists of 60 minutes dress rehearsal & 30 minutes presentation. During the rehearsal sessions, everyone joins in the excitement of getting ready to share their efforts with an audience. All show costumes and props are provided and each student gets a chance to select those that best meet their character's needs.

Performance Option:

Level 1 & 2: As scheduled / Chorus roles (ages 6-13): 26 hours / Principal roles (ages 9-13): 40 hours ON STAGE! — A great way to get into the show & shine as never before!

Students will enhance their skills and experience through the enriching and unforgettable experience of acting in a full musical play in a professional theatrical environment, under professional stage direction. The production will include character roles, vocal music and choreography, as well as full sets and costumes. Students must be registered for at least one of our class programs (above). Chorus roles are open to all students; principal roles are open at all students age 9 and up. Rehearsals will be scheduled (on Saturday mornings, by preference) through the course of the year; dress rehearsals and performances will be the final week of May and the first week of June.

Our curriculum goals:

Students will work together to participate in a set of enjoyable and challenging drama, movement and music activities. Self-awareness and ease of communication will be enhanced through observation and exploration. Social interaction and participation will be encouraged by the practice of rotating partner groups. The goal is to allow students to acquire and develop performance skills, to form new friendships, and to build a sense of confidence and the capacity for collaboration.


